We are back to normal... well back to our pre-COVID state. Residents are now eating together and back in group activities. Yesterday we had a number of them going through a Haunted House that activities set up on the lower level. What a great job they did and the residents loved it. The following interventions and actions continue to be in place:

- Approved unvaccinated staff continue to wear an N95 mask, surgical mask and eye protection at all times and in all resident/patient care areas.
- All other staff are wearing a surgical mask and eye protection at all times and in all resident/patient care areas.
- We screen all staff, visitors, vendors, and other healthcare providers upon entering the building.
- All residents are assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.
- We test all approved non-vaccinated staff two times per week per state guidelines

Booster Vaccine:

Will be here on November 18th; the pharmacy has finally gotten us set up.

NH Transmission Rate:

New Hampshire remains in the **RED** zone for transmission rate; one of the highest states in the country now.

From Barbara (activities):

We are getting ready to recognize the Veterans that are staying here with us. The Central School band will be coming to perform for the Residents on Veterans Day. We are asking families to provide a picture of your loved one (that is staying with us), in uniform, and what branch of service they served in. We will be recognizing them and displaying their pictures in our lobby area. Please submit a **copy** of the photo, with the resident's name written on the back. Visitation Guidelines:

Please remember that due to staffing limitations and the number of visitors allowed in the building at any one time, we request that visits be scheduled in advance.

To Schedule a Visit:

1. Go To: <https://mtcarmelrehabcenter.org/family-members/appointments/>
2. Read this page.
3. Near the bottom is where you can schedule a visit; you are able to select either a "Window/Lobby Visit" OR a "Room Visit"
4. Select the date and time slot you would like; (if the date and/or time is not available it will not allow you to select it.
 - ❖ **If you have any problems scheduling a visit please call Barbra Gray, Life Enrichment Director, Monday-Friday at 935-4607 and she can assist you.**
 - ❖ **If criteria are met, compassionate care visits are being scheduled by the nursing staff on the particular floor your loved one is residing. We request that these visits be scheduled in advance. Please call the floor(s) directly to schedule your visit @ 627-3811 and follow the prompts to get to a particular floor.**

Reminder - Last Minute Visits:

Our online visit scheduling system doesn't allow you to book a visit unless it is more than 3-days out. But, you can call on the current day and if there is an opening you can come in.

To make it a bit easier, you can call our receptionist (instead of Barbara) and ask her the availability of open times for a **same day visit** (she will not schedule regular visits, those need to be done online). Also, to accommodate weekend visits slots that may go unfilled, you can call the receptionist by 4:00 on Friday's and she can let you know if there are open slots over the weekend that are available. Hopefully, this will streamline the same day or weekend scheduling process for everyone. **Remember this is for same day/next day visits and weekend visits only not for the general scheduling of a visit.** Lastly, you are also welcome to come in as often as you would like based on the availability of open unscheduled time slots. Hope this helps those of you that have been wanting to come in more often.

NOTICE: We request that all visitors comply with the guidelines for visiting. If we find visitors wandering around the facility i.e. the lobby area, dining rooms etc. your visits going forward will be changed to a monitored in-lobby visit going forward. This will also apply if you do not follow the masking rules. We have seen unvaccinated visitors take their mask off once they get into the room; this IS NOT allowed. Thank you in advance for your cooperation with our visitation guidelines. For the vast majority of you that do follow the guideline we thank you 😊
