Hello Everyone,

Late yesterday another positive resident was identified. They were from the 2nd floor and have been moved to the quarantine section on the 4th floor. This resident and most all other residents on the second floor will received the monoclonal antibodies treatment tomorrow. The resident does not have any symptoms at this time.

The second person testing positive today works on the 2nd floor; she works 7pm to 11am. Her last day worked was this past Sunday into Monday. As of Sunday, at midnight she was negative. She has not worked since Monday 7am.

Yesterday and today we PCR tested all staff; hopefully all results will be in by tomorrow as the lab will be closed on Friday.

The following interventions are in place:

- The residents that the LNA came in contact with were placed on quarantine and staff are wearing full enhanced PPE when caring for them.
- Approved unvaccinated staff continue to wear an N95 mask, surgical mask and eye protection at all times and in all resident/patient care areas.
- All other staff are wearing a surgical mask an N95 and eye protection at all times and in all resident/patient care areas.
- All residents are assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.
- We screen all staff, visitors, vendors, and other healthcare providers upon entering the building.
- We test all approved non-vaccinated staff (1), two times per week per state guidelines
