Hello Everyone,

We had a Dietary Aid test positive today however, she has not been on any floors and last worked 1/7 in the kitchen. We also had a new Rehab person (first day), test positive, she was here on 1/7, did not treat anyone and was only in the rehab office. We believe both of these people contracted COVID from the outside.

We PCR tested residents yesterday and staff today and tomorrow. We also test as needed by an inhouse antigen test.

The following interventions are in place:

- All residents are wearing and being reminded to wear a mask when out of their room, **when with a visitor**, and during care, (difficult on 3rd floor).
- All staff on the 3rd floor are wearing a surgical gown/mask, an N95 and eye protection at all times and in all resident/patient care areas.
- All other staff are wearing a surgical mask, an N95 and eye protection at all times and in all resident/patient care areas.
- All residents are assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.
- We screen all staff, visitors, vendors, and other healthcare providers upon entering the building.
- We are testing following the outbreak guidelines which is once weekly of all staff and residents. We are also doing an antigen test as needed for staff and residents if anything is suspected.
