Hello Everyone,

All test results for the week are back; we had no positive test results. 😊

Because we need to have a two-week break in positive tests we will have to do PCR testing again Sunday through Wednesday for all residents and all staff. If we have no positive results we will be considered out of outbreak status.

Total COVID positive staff and residents = 0

The following interventions continue to be in place:

- All residents are wearing and being reminded to wear a mask when out of their room, **when with a visitor**, and during care, (difficult on 3rd floor).
- All staff are wearing a surgical mask, an N95 and eye protection at all times and in all resident/patient care areas.
- All residents are assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.
- We screen all staff, visitors, vendors, and other healthcare providers upon entering the building.
- We are testing following the outbreak guidelines which is once weekly of all staff and residents. We are also doing an antigen test as needed for staff and residents if anything is suspected.
