Hello Everyone,

All test results for the week are back; we had no positive test results.

We are now considered **out of outbreak** status; BUT waiting for the official word from the Manchester Health Department which we will probably hear back on Monday due to the storm today.

On 2/27 we will start testing following CMS guidelines, which is an antigen test twice weekly, of all non-boosted staff (no residents). We are however, doing antigen test as needed for residents if anything is suspected.

You may have heard that we did have the Norovirus go throughout the building this past week affecting several residents and staff. If all stays as is currently, we should be past it as of tomorrow. We heard from the Manchester Health Department that it is going through most all nursing homes right now.

Total COVID positive staff and residents = 0

The following interventions are in place:

- All residents are wearing and being reminded to wear a mask when out of their room, **when with a visitor**, and during care, (difficult on 3rd floor).
- All staff are wearing a surgical mask, an N95 and eye protection at all times and in all resident/patient care areas.
- All residents are assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.
- We screen all staff, visitors, vendors, and other healthcare providers upon entering the building.
