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Hello Everyone,

We received test results back yesterday and had a resident on the 3rd floor test positive. They have been relocated/isolated to the Annex COVID unit. We also had a dietary aide test positive today; they only work in the kitchen and not on the floor. We still have a few outstanding tests we are awaiting results on from this week's testing.

The following interventions continue to be in place:

- All staff are wearing an N95 and eye protection at all times in all resident/patient care areas.
- We are keeping residents on 2nd floor separated; residents on the other floors can be out and about with a mask and need to be one per table when dining or doing an activity. They are not quarantined to their room.
- All residents are wearing and being reminded to wear a mask when out of their room, **when with a visitor**, and during care, (difficult on 3rd floor).
- All residents are assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.
- We screen all staff, visitors, vendors, and other healthcare providers upon entering the building.
- We are testing following the outbreak guidelines which is once weekly of all staff and residents until we achieve two weeks with no positives. We are also doing an antigen test as needed for staff and residents if anything is suspected.
