Hello Everyone,

We learned yesterday that an LNA tested positive at home on Friday night. At this time, we believe they were exposed outside of Mt. Carmel. Also, yesterday we had three of the isolated residents return back to their rooms on the 2nd floor.

The following interventions continue to be in place:

- All staff are wearing an N95 and eye protection at all times in all resident/patient care areas.
- We are keeping residents on 2nd floor separated; residents on the other floors can be out and about with a mask and need to be one per table when dining or doing an activity. Other than positive residents, no other residents are being isolated in their room.
- All residents are wearing and being reminded to wear a mask when out of their room, **when with a visitor**, and during care, (difficult on 3rd floor).
- All residents are assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.
- We screen all staff, visitors, vendors, and other healthcare providers upon entering the building.
- We are testing following the outbreak guidelines which is once weekly of all staff and residents until we achieve two weeks with no positives. We are also doing an antigen test as needed for staff and residents if anything is suspected.
