Hello Everyone,

An LNA on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor tested positive yesterday; she last worked on 10/10 on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor.

Due to this positive case, we will remain in an outbreak status for another two weeks.

**The following interventions continue to be in place:**

- Staff on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor are wearing a medical mask and eye protection at all times in all resident/patient care areas (full PPE for any resident(s) in isolation, N95, eye protection, gowns, gloves).
- All staff on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, are wearing an N95 and eye protection at all times in all resident/patient care areas (full PPE for any resident(s) in isolation, N95, eye protection, gown, and gloves).
- All staff on the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor, are wearing an N95, eye protection, a gown and gloves as appropriate, at all times in all resident/patient care areas.
- We are keeping each resident floor separated from one another.
- Residents (non-COVID positive), on all floors can be out and about with a mask. However, on 2<sup>nd</sup> floor they are encouraged to maintain 6' distancing and are being set one per table for dining.
- All residents are wearing and being reminded to wear a mask when out of their room, when with a visitor, and during care, (difficult on 3<sup>rd</sup> floor).
- **All residents are assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.**
- **We are currently testing weekly all staff and residents. We are also doing an antigen test as needed for staff and residents if anything is suspected.**
- We screen all staff, visitors, vendors upon entering the building.
