We learned yesterday that 3 residents on the 2nd floor tested positive and today an additional 3 residents on 2nd tested positive. All but one has been put into isolation on the Annex.

We also had an LNA positive today, they last worked today and the 2nd floor.

Due to these positive cases, we will remain in an outbreak status for another two weeks.

The following interventions continue to be in place:

- Staff on 3rd and 4th floors are wearing a medical mask and eye protection at all times in all resident/patient care areas (full PPE for any resident(s) in isolation, N95, eye protection, gowns, gloves).
- Staff on 2nd floor are wearing an N95 and eye protection at all times in all resident/patient care areas (full PPE for any resident(s) in isolation, N95, eye protection, gowns, gloves).
- We are currently keeping each resident floor separated from one another.
- Residents (non-COVID positive), on 3rd and 4th floors can be out and about with a mask.
- Residents on the 2nd floor are being kept 6' apart when/where possible at dining tables and no group activities.
- All residents are wearing and being reminded to wear a mask when out of their room, when with a visitor, and during care, (difficult on 3rd floor).
- **All residents are assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.**
- **We are currently testing weekly all staff and residents. We are also doing an antigen test as needed for staff and residents if anything is suspected.**
- We screen all staff, visitors, vendors upon entering the building.
