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Just wanted you to know that we have heard from the city health department and are no longer in outbreak status as of Monday the 28th. Reminder that it only takes one positive staff or resident to put us back in outbreak status.

As of today, we have changed our visitor check-in process; I hope you to find it more welcoming. We are also allowing more freedom for visitors to be in the common areas. This will all be outlined in the handout you will receive upon check-in.

The following interventions continue to be in place:

- Staff on all floors are wearing a medical mask at all times in all resident/patient care areas (full PPE for any resident(s) in isolation, N95, eye protection, gowns, gloves).
- All residents are wearing and being reminded to wear a mask when out of their room, when with a visitor, and during care, (difficult on 3rd floor).
- **All residents are assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.**
- **We are also doing an antigen test as needed for staff and residents if anything is suspected.**
