Hello Everyone,

Just wanted to let you know that we had an administrative staff member test positive on 3/31/23, they last worked on Thursday on the main floor no direct resident contact. This has been traced to this individual shares office space with the individual that tested positive on Tuesday.

We continue to remain in "outbreak" status because we have not had two full weeks or 14 days without a positive case. We currently have no active residents with Covid in the building. Two staff members are on isolation and have not returned to work. We continue to test all staff and residents at least once weekly.

The following interventions are currently in place:

- Staff on all floors are wearing a medical mask at all times and eye protection (depending on the severity level in the county), in all resident/patient care areas.
- Staff on all floors are wearing full PPE for any resident(s) in isolation, (N95, eye protection, gowns, gloves).
- All residents are being reminded to wear a mask when out of their room, when with a visitor, and during care, (difficult on 3rd floor).
- All residents are assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.
- We are also doing an antigen test as needed for staff and residents if anything is suspected.
