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Hello Everyone,

Yesterday we had another nursing staff member test positive.

We currently have eleven cases on 2nd, 1 on 3rd and 4 staff; we continue to be in outbreak status.

We will be testing all staff and residents for the next two weeks.

The following interventions continue to be in place:

- Staff on all floors are wearing a medical mask and eye protection at all times in all resident/patient care areas.
- Staff on all floors are wearing full PPE for any resident(s) in isolation, (N95, eye protection, gowns, gloves), (none at this time).
- All residents on all floor are being reminded to wear a mask when out of their room, when with a visitor, and during care (a bit difficult on third floor).
- All residents are being assessed for signs and symptoms of Covid-19, 2 times a day and if there is a noticeable change in their condition.
- We are also doing an antigen test as needed for staff and residents if anything is suspected.
- **Visitors are encouraged** but not required to wear a mask when visiting.

Please note:

We recommend that you wear a mask while visiting especially 2nd floor.

Please remember if you have any sniffles it may not be allergies it could be the start of COVID. We highly recommend that you test yourself and keep those around you safe.
